- What We Do** Orenco Systems® designs and manufactures leading-edge equipment for onsite and decentralized water/wastewater systems. Our small-diameter effluent sewers allow communities to install wastewater collection systems at low cost. Our advanced treatment systems produce such clear odorless effluent that it can be reused for subsurface irrigation or other beneficial uses.
- Products and Services** Products include watertight tanks, basins, scrubbers, and wet wells; pumping and filtration systems; secondary treatment systems (including AdvanTex® textile filters in a range of sizes for residential, commercial, municipal, and mobile applications); community effluent sewer (STEP) systems; standard and custom electronic control equipment; and fiberglass shelters. We provide technical sales support for all our customers, ongoing support for system operators, and design guidance for large systems.
- Markets** Individual homes and businesses use Orenco's fiberglass tanks, pumping systems, secondary wastewater treatment systems, and electrical controls. Growing communities needing to create, replace, or expand wastewater collection and treatment networks use Orenco's Effluent Sewer and AdvanTex Treatment Systems. Oil, gas, and mining operations use Orenco's mobile wastewater plants. In addition to electronic controls and telemetry for wastewater systems, Orenco also manufactures custom and OEM electronic controls and industrial fiberglass products for a variety of industries.
- Facilities** The company has 477,000 total sq ft (44,315 sq m) of facilities under roof in the following locations:
- Sutherlin, Oregon: 150,000 sq ft (13,935 sq m) of facilities on a 26-acre (10.5-ha) site
 - Winchester, Oregon: 137,000 sq ft (12,728 sq m) of facilities on a 45-acre (18.2-ha) site
 - Wilbur, Oregon: 190,000 sq ft (17,652 sq m) of facilities on a 4.5-acre (1.8-ha) site
- Distribution** Wastewater products are sold from about 300 points of distribution in North America, Central & South America, Australasia, Europe, and Africa. Custom controls are sold through many of these same distribution points, as well as through direct OEM relationships.
- Ownership** Orenco is a privately owned company, governed by a Board of Directors that includes Hal Ball, P.E., President; Terry Bounds, P.E., Executive Vice President; Eric Ball, P.E., Vice President, Product Development; and Jeff Ball, P.E., Vice President, Operations.
- History** Orenco Systems®, Inc. was established in 1981. The company pioneered the use of effluent sewers and sand filters for decentralized wastewater collection and treatment in Oregon. In 2000, Orenco introduced its flagship product, the AdvanTex® textile filter, and about 30,000 AdvanTex filters are now in use. In 2001, Orenco introduced its VeriComm® Remote Telemetry Control Panel and Monitoring System — a scaled-down SCADA system priced for the residential onsite wastewater market. In 2014, Orenco launched its Composites division for manufacturing of large-scale industrial composites products. Orenco's owners hold multiple U.S. and international patents. Their research is cited in numerous textbooks and publications, and Orenco's engineers are regularly asked to give workshops and presentations. Orenco maintains an environmental lab and invests time and money in a continuing research program, often in cooperation with universities.
